This book has some traditional origami and some I haven't seen elsewhere (I have 15 or so origami books). The models in the book range from fairly easy to somewhat difficult (for me), and I have 3 models to go before completing them all. (Only a couple appeared in my "easy" origami books.) I've enjoyed every one of them. My favorite models in the past have been the more symmetrical types - boxes, flowers, stars, boats etc - this book has animals and birds which I used to have more trouble with, but Tremaine's book got me "over the hump" and now I enjoy folding them as well. I will be making several of the models more than once, for sure. The instructions are fantastic, and include written directions and diagrams showing each action, plus an "action photo" showing hands doing the fold, so you get two ways of seeing what to do. It works. I like Mr. Tremaine's folksy,

easy-going approach in the text and his brief descriptions and history of some of the models. It's obvious that he enjoys his art and enjoys teaching it as well. He also suggests types of paper and often paper sizes - so you don't end up trying some models with paper that turns out to be too small. The symbols, folds, and bases used in the book are all well presented. When you start doing origami and become bored with the really easy stuff, this is a great book to get you going onto more interesting and challenging things. I now feel ready to try some of the models in my other books that just didn't make sense before I worked through Tremaine's book.

It has beautiful pictures, very clear and easy to follow instructions, and directions for both classical origami models and original models. We also enjoyed reading the information included about the history and social significance of many models.

Flowers, animals, boxes, and buildings are among the three-dimensional paper figures that can be created with the traditional Japanese art of paper-folding. The Amazing Book of Origami includes step-by-step, full-color photographs detailing the techniques of origami and showing how to manipulate paper at each stage of preparation. As a result, the exceptionally clear instructions in this beautifully illustrated volume are easy to follow, showing the symbols, standard folds, and bases that are used to create most of the models. Author Jon Tremaine was introduced to origami in the 1950's by Robert Harbin, who has been long recognized as the Englishman who made origami well-known in the West.
