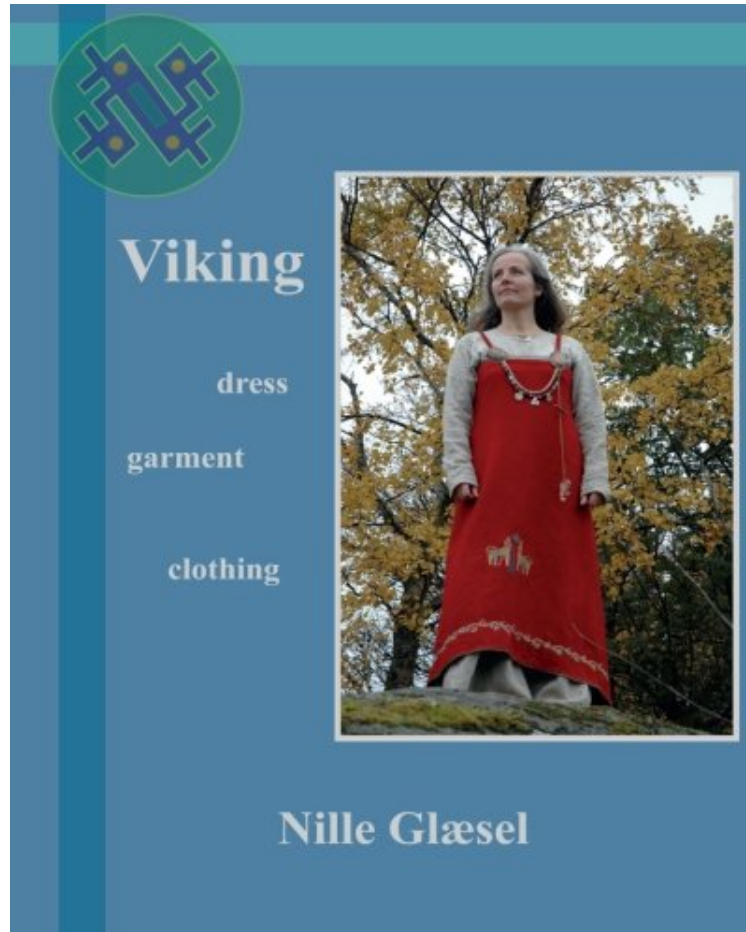

The only grump I have is that the charts for sizes and conversions did not translate well and are somewhat hard to figure out. The female and male children's outfits are just a repeat of the adult version. These sections could have easily been added together with a note for any changes that needed to be done for children. Price is too high for what you get so look for a good used book instead of buying new. Other sections on braiding and tablet weaving were less than useful if you are planning on doing that type of work and you would be better off buying a book specific to those methods.
