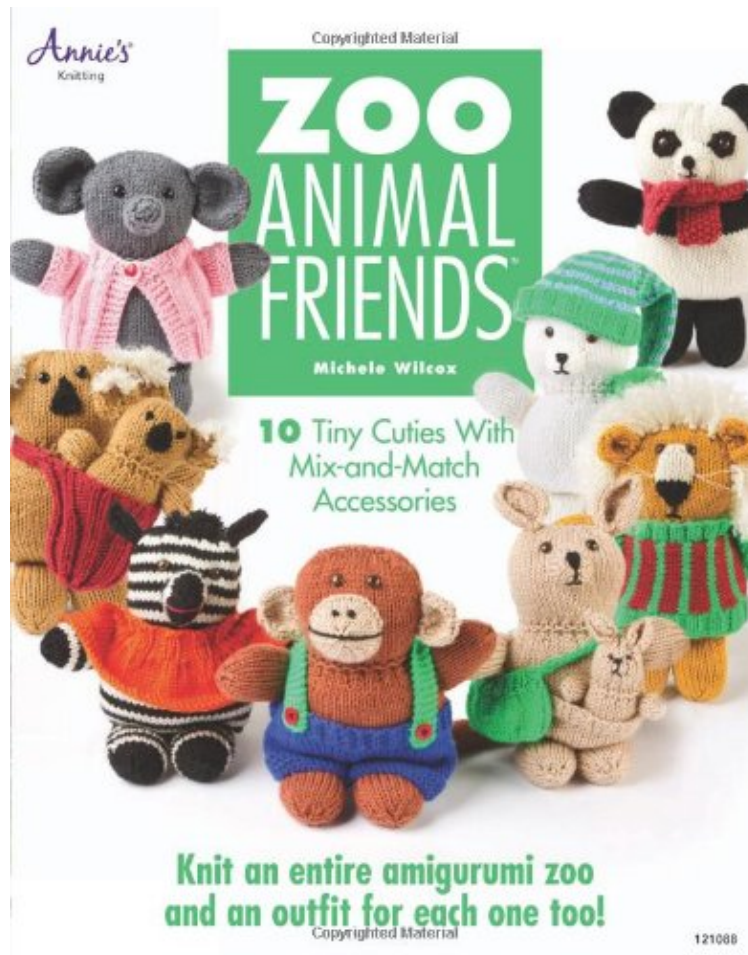

Zoo Animal Friends by Michele Wilcox and published by Annie's provides directions to make 8 different zoo animals and babies for two of them. There are also cute mix-and-match accessories. Great features are that one uses worsted yarn and size 6 needles, and the animals are about 11 inches tall. Also, the same basic body, arms and legs are made for each animal. Yarn colors, facial features, ears, tails, and in the case of the kangaroo, a pouch, distinguish animals from one another. Other pluses are that the book is reasonably priced at the list price of \$11.95 and it is printed in the U.S.A. I consider myself an advanced knitter, this book is a bit amateurish for me, so after I look at it long enough, it will be gifted to my little niece, and come summer I will be teaching her to knit from it.

Basic body shapes and mix-and-match extremities create the variety of miniature creatures in this amigurumi how-to guide for intermediate knitters. The small, handmade projects are easy to personalize, and all of the designs use the same soft worsted-weight yarn. Featured zoo animals include an elephant, a kangaroo with baby, a koala with baby, a lion, a monkey, a panda, a polar bear, and a zebra, each approximately 11 inches tall. Every animal's wardrobe can be completed with the clothing and accessory designs that offer sweaters, scarves, hats, purses, ponchos, and more.
